Wind and temperature data recorded at the C.A.A. Airways Communication station, Bellingham airport, is shown for Wednesday morning through noon.

The minimum of 2 degrees (actually 1.9) below zero occurred between 4:30 and 5:30 a.m. and is not shown in the chart, since the weather warmed up at the next hourly reading. Wind gusts were not a major factor Wednesday.
